Applications are invited for appointment as a Senior Research Assistant/Research Assistant I in the Department of English Language Education. He/She will provide support to the research team, and perform academic duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator. Research experience in education-related research projects is highly desirable. The initial appointment will be for a period of 12 months with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

For the post of Senior Research Assistant, applicants should have at least a Master's Degree in applied linguistics or educational psychology, or a related discipline, with knowledge of qualitative and quantitative methodology plus one year post Master's Degree full-time working experience. For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in related disciplines. They should also have good communication and organizational skills, high level of proficiency in spoken and written English and Chinese (especially Mandarin), good ability to work independently. Candidates with research experiences will be an advantage. Immediate availability is preferred.
