The appointee will be responsible for promoting educational and pedagogical innovations in virtual environments and new generation learning spaces. Duties include designing and conducting showcase tours for a range of stakeholders in the education sector (e.g., students, teachers, principals); contributing to small projects related to using the Metaverse for education; coordinating an ambassador scheme for university students; producing presentation materials; collecting data for evaluation; and drafting project reports. He/she will be expected to carry out other duties as assigned by the Centre Director. The appointment will be for a period of one year.

Applicants should possess a recognized Bachelor's Degree in Psychology, Social Sciences or related disciplines, with 2 years of post-qualification working experience, preferably in tertiary institutions or local school sector. They should be interested in artificial intelligence (AI), augmented reality (AR)/virtual reality (VR)/ mixed reality (MR) and emerging technologies. They should have good interpersonal and communication skills, the ability to work independently and work as a good team coordinator and player; have good written and verbal communication skills with high proficiency in both spoken and written English and Chinese (being fluent in Cantonese is a must).
