The Academy of Hong Kong Studies (AHKS), established in July 2015, is the first academy dedicated to fostering Hong Kong Studies within local tertiary institutions. It is an interdisciplinary academy at The Education University of Hong Kong.

The appointees will be mainly assigned to implement various projects under the supervision of Professor Stephen Chiu, including career and life education, community studies, and Chinese medicine. He/ She will assist in different tasks including collecting data, interviewing participants, data input, transcribing and coding, and managing administrative work.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree or above in Social Science disciplines. Good communication skills and command of both spoken and written English and Chinese are essential. Quantitative skills and experiences in survey research are an advantage.

The appointee will also be occasionally required to perform duties in non-regular hours.
