The appointee will be responsible for providing research and administration supports to an e-Pedagogy project which aims to develop a range of e-pedagogies and create multiple virtual classrooms for enhancing the quality of online learning and teaching. Main duties include supporting programme leaders and course teachers in the trialing of eLearning resources and pedagogies, conducting literature review, liaison with internal teaching staff and partnership schools, conducting interviews and data analysis, organizing training workshops, preparing of training packages, collecting and analyzing school practice in e-learning, compiling reports and good practices in e-learning.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Educational Technology, Information Technology in Education, Technology-enhanced Learning, Education, Psychology, Computer Sciences, Engineering, or related disciplines. Preference will be given to applicants who have relevant working experience related to learning and teaching in schools or higher education. Applicants should have an excellent command of written English and Chinese, good interpersonal and communication skills, high proficiency in English, Chinese and Cantonese, preferably with some experience in undertaking research and using different data analysis software such as SPSS and NVivo. They should be mature, a good team player, detail-oriented and able to work independently. Immediate available is preferred.
