

## Senior Lecturer II / Lecturer I/II (Ref: 2200839) Department of Special Education and Counselling Faculty of Education and Human Development

The Department is now seeking qualified and highly dedicated colleague for the teaching position at the rank of Senior Lecturer II in the area of counselling, or any other relevant areas. The appointee will be responsible for teaching duties for undergraduate and postgraduate programmes in counselling and counselling related courses; contributing to programme development; engaging in departmental and faculty services, or any other tasks assigned by the Head of the Department. They may also be required to supervise students on teaching practice and counselling practicum.

Applicants with expertise in the following areas are welcome to apply:

Counselling/Counselling related disciplines, with extensive clinical practice in communities, and/or with teaching experiences in tertiary institutions.

For the post of Senior Lecturer II, applicants should have a Master's degree in a relevant subject discipline plus a minimum of 8 years' relevant post-qualification practice or teaching experience in counselling or related areas; or preferably a Doctoral degree plus a minimum of 3 years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience in the subject applied for.

For the post of Lecturer I, applicants should have a Master's degree in a relevant subject discipline plus a minimum of 4 years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience in teaching of students with special educational needs. Applicants who have less relevant post-qualification teaching experience in the subject applied for will be considered for the post of Lecturer II.

Proven evidence of professional experience at schools, NGOs, and/or teaching experiences in tertiary institution is required. Significant contributions to professional development and/or education programmes/practicum coordination are an advantage. It would be advantageous to applicants to have the ability to teach through more than one medium of instruction (English/Cantonese/Putonghua).

Applicants should preferably possess a relevant professional teaching certificate, e.g. PGDE or qualification of Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) recognized by the Education Bureau of Hong Kong or other qualification of equivalence.
