

Educational Development Officer (Ref: 2200952) Centre for Learning, Teaching and Technology

The appointee will be responsible for supporting curriculum development to an education project. Duties include developing, refining and translating learning and teaching materials for senior primary school students, offering supports in professional development courses for teachers, and liaising with internal and external parties. He/she will be expected to carry out other duties as assigned by the Project Director. The appointment will be for a period of around 24 months.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree, preferably in, Educational Technology, Education, Psychology, Social Sciences or related disciplines, with at least two years' post-qualification fulltime working experience. Experience in developing or teaching programming language, such as Scratch, App Inventor or STEM will be an advantage. Applicants should be proficient in both English and Chinese (fluent in spoken Cantonese is a must); attentive to details; and with good interpersonal and communication skills. They should be self-motivated and able to work as a team member. Immediate availability is preferred.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
