The appointee will be responsible for providing executive support to educational projects by undertaking a wide range of duties, including but not limited to data collection, writing reports, handling relevant administrative paperwork, helping designing education materials related to Chinese Language or Chinese history connected with psychology and counseling for primary and secondary students, assisting with compiling and editing documents, liaising with external and internal parties, and performing ad-hoc tasks assigned by his/her immediate supervisor. The successful candidate will start working around early November 2022. The initial appointment will be for a period of around 5 months.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Chinese Language, Chinese History, History, Education, Psychology, Counseling or any other cognate disciplines. Experience in school teaching or counseling will be a definite advantage. They should have high proficiency in both English and Chinese (Cantonese and Putonghua), and excellent interpersonal and communication skills. They should also be self-motivated, and capable of working independently and collaboratively. Preference will be given to applicants who process some relevant experience working as a Research Assistant or Project Assistant in the tertiary education sector. Immediate availability is preferred.
