The appointee will provide research support to education-related projects. Major duties include conducting literature search; developing research materials; collecting data; and conducting statistical analyses including exploratory and confirmatory factor analyses and structural equation modeling, also performing any other duties as assigned by supervising officers. The appointment will be for a period of 13 months and up to 31 December 2023, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Education, Statistics, Psychology or other related disciplines, preferably with relevant post-qualification working experience. For the post of Research Assistant II, applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Applicants should have high proficiency in both English and Chinese. They should also be meticulous; able to work independently or as a team member and work under pressure. Applicants with working experience in local tertiary education institutions will be an advantage. Immediately available is highly preferred.
