The appointee will be responsible for providing research and engagement support to the Department of Early Childhood Education. He/She will be responsible for developing and executing strategies for promoting research and engagement activities locally and internationally; producing compelling content in written, visual, and video formats for use in multiple communication channels, including website, and social media platforms; identifying new opportunities to increase the positive impact of our research and engagement activities; collecting, tracking and reporting on the research and engagement activities in the department; organizing international and local seminars, events, and student study/exchange tours; and other duties as assigned by the supervisor. Occasional travel may be required. The appointment will be for a period of 6 months.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Translation, Communication, Journalism, Marketing, or a related discipline, with at least 2 years of post-qualification full-time experience in corporate communication; highly proficiency in English and Chinese (including Putonghua); strong communication, writing, and editing skills; proactive, innovative, and able to work under pressure; Prior experience in managing social media, using graphic design software or promoting research projects will be an advantage. Immediate availability is preferred.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
