Our research and teaching relate to leadership, innovation, entrepreneurialism, teacher and professional development, organizational studies, education law, policy studies, and professionalism in local, regional, and international education contexts. Increasingly, we engage the education sector beyond schools, such as private, corporate, and non-governmental organizations with education and training service units.
