The appointee will assist in duties such as literature review, data collection and analysis, and report, and any other duties as assigned. The appointment will be initially made for a period of 12 months, which can be further extended upon mutual agreement.

For the post of Senior Research Assistant, applicants should have a Master's Degree in Education, Psychology, or other related disciplines plus one year's post master's degree full-time working experience, or a doctorate.

For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Education, Psychology, or other related disciplines, preferably with relevant post-qualification full-time working experience, or an approved qualification or equivalent standard.

Applicants should be adept at multi-tasking, working under tight deadlines and be able to work both independently and as a team. They should also have an excellent command of written English, especially in academic writing. Past experience of using quantitative research software (e.g., SPSS, AMOS) will be an advantage.
