The Department of Psychology seeks to recruit emerging scholars at the rank of *Assistant Professor*. Our Department currently has 34 full-time academic and teaching staff. The appointee will participate in activities related to research, teaching, project supervision, curriculum and programme development, and programme and course management at undergraduate to postgraduate levels.
