

**Assistant Educational Development Officer (Holding the substantive rank of Educational Development Assistant) (Ref: 2201270)

The appointee will be responsible for providing educational development support for various activities in the Centre. Duties include drawing up and maintaining inventory of equipment and software licenses; liaising with colleagues for purchasing needs; arranging regular inspections of machinery and equipment; assisting with the organisation of staff professional development and student activities related to development of digital competencies, as well as learning and teaching in general. The appointee will also be expected to carry out other duties as assigned by the Centre Director.

Applicants should possess a recognized Bachelor's degree. Being familiar with website development, and having an interest in STEM, robotics, 3D printing, and/or other educational technologies will be an advantage. They should be proficient in English and Chinese (fluent in Cantonese is a must), have great attention to detail, and good interpersonal and communication skills. Immediate availability is preferred.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
