We are examining pre-service language teachers' digital literacy competence and are seeking a bright Research Assistant I to collect and analyse data to help us understand and strengthen their digital literacy competencies. The appointee will provide support to the research team in multiple tasks, such as collecting and analysing data from participants and developing and evaluating an innovative teacher-education training program, etc. He/she will also perform any other academic duties as assigned by the project investigator(s) or his/her delegate(s). The initial appointment will be for a period of 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have at least a Bachelor's Degree (preferable a Master's Degree) in Education, English, Applied Linguistics or other education-related disciplines, with solid knowledge of quantitative and qualitative methodology. Relevant research experience would be an advantage. They should also have good communication and organizational skills, a high proficiency in spoken and written English and Chinese, and a good ability to work independently and collaboratively.
