The AHKS now invites applications for a Post-doctoral Fellowship.

The appointee will be required to write research grant proposals, complete research projects leading to publication in academic journals, and supervise student interns / student helpers. The appointee will also be deployed to support other functions of the AHKS as appropriate.

Applicants should be fresh doctoral graduates from Social Sciences disciplines, who are dedicated to Hong Kong Studies. They should also have an emerging record of scholarship in the field of Hong Kong Studies. Good proposal writing skills, in both English and Chinese, is a MUST. Applicants with strong knowledge and fieldwork experience in sociology of sports, inter-global city studies, regional integration, and Greater Bay Area will have an advantage. **Applicants are requested to submit their applications together with a formal research proposal on a topic relating to "Hong Kong as a Global City" (in English, not more than 10 double-spaced typed pages).**
