

Educational Development Officer / Educational Development Assistant

The appointee will be responsible for supporting an inter-institutional initiative on authentic assessment which aims to build capacity among Academic/ Teaching staff to adopt more formative approaches to assessment, and to transform their assessment and feedback practices with a view to enhancing students' self-regulated learning. Duties include coordinating Community of Practice (CoP) activities among Academic/ Teaching staff and students in two universities (e.g., seminars, workshops, sharing sessions, interviews), conducting literature reviews, assisting in evaluation exercise of the project, and compiling project publications and reports. The appointee will also be expected to carry out other duties as assigned by the Centre Director. The appointment will be for a period of 2 years.

Applicants should possess a recognized Bachelor's degree in Education, Psychology, Social Sciences, or related disciplines, with 2 years of post-qualification working experience, preferably gained in tertiary institutions. They should have proficiency in common e-learning tools, excellent language skills in both English and Chinese (fluent in Cantonese is a must), great attention to detail, and good interpersonal and communication skills. Immediate availability is preferred. Candidates with less experience may be considered for the post of Educational Development Assistant.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
