Increasing Access to High Quality Online English Language Learning Materials for Primary Students in Hong Kong

[Appointment Period: Around 10 months]

We are seeking a Senior Research Assistant / Research Assistant I in the Department of English Language Education. The appointee will assist ELE staff members on a project involving the production of online English language learning materials for primary school students, animation and e-books. The main duties will include the support and supervision of lesson planning and materials design; the design of e-books and online language learning activities; and ensuring the coherence and quality of content. Related responsibilities include providing administrative and technical support to the university team (including report writing); coordinating between the project team, production studio and website design teams; and assisting in the piloting and promotion of content in local schools. The appointment will be for a period of around 10 months with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

For the post of Senior Research Assistant, applicants should have a Master's Degree in English Language Education, I.T. in Education, or other related fields, plus one-year post Master's Degree full-time working experience, or a Doctoral Degree. For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in the above mentioned disciplines. Local primary school teaching experience and familiarity with video editing and website design are not required but will be an advantage.
