Applicants should possess a recognized Bachelor's Degree in Education, Psychology, Mathematics, or related disciplines, preferably with a Master's degree. Candidates with past experience of using quantitative or qualitative research method will be advantageous. Applicants should have high proficiency in both written and spoken English and Chinese; self-motivation, ability to work independently and in a team, and willing to learn to handle unfamiliar tasks. Preference will be given to those with educational research experience.
