The appointee will work on a research project in developmental cognitive neuroscience. He/she will support the research team in planning, conducting, and coordinating the project activities. The appointee will conduct literature review, data collection, data entry, data management and analysis, report and manuscript writing, and liaison with schools and organizations. The initial appointment will be for a period of 6 months with the possibility of renewal.

The applicants should have a bachelor's degree in psychology, cognitive neuroscience, or a related discipline; interest in brain-behavior relationships; good communication, presentation, and interpersonal skills in both written and spoken English and Chinese (Cantonese); strong administrative and management skills; research knowledge and skills in using SPSS; enthusiasm, self-motivation, and the ability to work independently and under pressure. Experience with programming (e.g., E-Prime, MATLAB) and/or cognitive neuroscience methods (e.g., EEG, fNIRS) will be an asset.
