The Centre for Research on Linguistics and Language Studies is looking for a Research Assistant for project related to corpus-based research. The appointee will be responsible for collecting and analysing relevant language data (Chinese and English), and tasks related to the development and maintenance of project databases. The appointment will be for around 5 months.

For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Linguistics, Language studies or any related fields. For the post of Research Assistant II, applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Applicants should have experience with corpus data analysis and process related linguistics skills. They should have excellent command in Chinese and English. Working knowledge in statistics would be an advantage.
