The appointment will provide support to the Principal Investigator on project arrangement. Duties include preparing test materials, interviewing teachers, documentation, liaising with internal and external stakeholders, conducting data collection and analysis and providing administrative support to scholarly activities. He/she is also required to perform any other duties as assigned. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Preference will be given to those have a Bachelor's Degree in preferably in Early Childhood Education or STEM-related disciplines, or other related disciplines with relevant post-qualification full-time working experience in ECE. Good command of written and spoken English and Chinese is essential. Applicants should also possess effective communication, organizational and analytical skills, be attentive to details and able to work independently. Immediate available preferred.
