The appointee will be responsible for teaching science-/environmental-related courses and teaching method courses in Science and STEM/STEAM education at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels. He/she is also required to assist in programme development and administration, supervising fieldwork, teaching practicum and student projects, and developing teaching modules and self-directed learning materials.

Applicants should have a Master's Degree in a relevant subject discipline, i.e. Science and/or Environment, plus a minimum of four years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience, with evidence of quality teaching and/or a record of successful relevant professional experience at primary/secondary and or tertiary level. Applicants who have less relevant post-qualification teaching experience will be considered for the post of Lecturer II.

Applicants should possess a relevant professional teaching certificate, i.e., qualification of Qualified Teacher Status recognised by the Education Bureau of Hong Kong or other equivalent qualifications. The appointee is expected to be highly versatile in what they would be able to teach and demonstrate excellent interpersonal skills. Applicants with expertise in creativity and/or e-learning in STEM/STEAM education are preferred.
