Online Discourse of Autism in Chinese Newspapers and Social Media [Appointment Period: 6 months]

The appointee will be responsible for reviewing literature, compiling corpora, using the corpora to analyse language data, conducting discourse analysis and so on. He or she is also expected to provide administrative support to the research team. The initial appointment will be for a period of 6 months with the possibility of renewal subject to agreement.

For the Post of Research Assistant I, applicants should have at least a Bachelor's Degree or above in Linguistics/ Communication / Psychology/ Sociology or related fields. For the post of Research Assistant II, applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. They should possess an excellent command of spoken and written English, a commitment to research, and the ability to write up research work for publications. Applicants with expertise in corpus linguistics and discourse analysis will be highly preferred. Knowledge of mental illness, counselling psychology and media studies is an advantage.
