The appointee will support the implementation of the research project entitled 'The social media discourses of a government-driven mental health campaign in Hong Kong'. He/she will assist in recruiting participants/interviewees, collecting and analyzing qualitative data, supervising student helpers and performing any other duties assigned by the project supervisor. The appointment will last for 8 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement and funding availability.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. He/she should have good proficiency in both spoken and written Chinese and English (equivalent to IELTS 6.5 or above). They should also have good communication skills, high level of self-motivation and the ability to work independently and in a team. Preference will be given to those with academic and/or work background in relevant fields such as mental health, (positive) psychology, (multimodal) discourse analysis, (socio)linguistics and applied linguistics.
