Applications are invited for the captioned position.

The School Partnership and Field Experience Office is looking for a motivated individual to join its team. Duties include organizing events and activities; preparing reports and proposal; providing secretariat support to office; working with relevant department to develop a FE system to streamline, digitalise and automate the FE-related materials and process; supporting and maintaining the enhancement of the office website and mobile app and performing any other duties as assigned by supervisor. The appointment will be for a period of one year.

Applicants should have a recognised degree, with normally 2 years or more of post-qualification working experience preferably in tertiary institutions or public organisations. Good interpersonal and communication skills, strong analytical, problem solving and organization skills, as well as and the ability to work independently or as a team member are required. They should be attentive to details, self-motivated, and able to work under pressure. Knowledge and experience in IT system development and management will be an advantage.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
