Project Title: Smart Vest for Improving Behavioral Performance of School-aged Children with Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)

The appointees will participate in various research projects related to human motion tracking and analysis with wearable sensors. They will be responsible for conducting literature review, digital system development, data collection, programming, data analysis and drafting research reports. They are also expected to provide administrative support to the research team. There will be opportunities for manuscript writing and publications in international journals. The appointment will be for a period of around 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants for Post-doctoral Fellow should have a Doctoral degree in Science/Engineering or related fields. They should have experiences in conducting research on data analysis, digital systems wearable device.

Applicants for Senior Research Assistant should have a Master's degree, plus one-year post Master's degree full-time working experience, or a Doctoral degree in Science/Engineering or related fields. They should have strong experiences in conducting research on data analysis, digital systems wearable device.

Applicants for Research Assistant I should have a Bachelor's Degree in Computer Science, Textile Engineering, Psychological Science, Occupational Science or related fields, preferably with a Master's Degree or above, or with relevant full-time working experience. They should have preliminary experiences in conducting research on data analysis, digital systems wearable device.

Applicants for Research Assistant II should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent, preferably with a Bachelor's Degree or above in Computer Science, Textile Engineering, Psychological Science, Occupational Science or related fields.

Applicants have good communication skills in both written and spoken English and Chinese.
