

Project Officer (Holding a functional title of Educational Development Officer)/ Project Assistant (Holding a functional title of Educational Development Assistant) (Ref: 2300199) Department of Curriculum and Instruction

In support of the Government's Job Creation Scheme 3.0 under the Anti-epidemic Fund, The Education University of Hong Kong has created positions covering a wide range of job functions and levels. This is in response to the difficult labour market situation in the wake of the pandemic, with an aim of providing employment opportunities for those with different skill sets, qualifications and years of experience. Applications are invited for the captioned position.

The appointee will be responsible for supporting an e-Pedagogy project which aims to develop a range of e-pedagogy and create multiple virtual classrooms for enhancing the quality of online learning and teaching.

The appointee is expected to provide the necessary administrative and technical support in designing, implementing, and evaluating the project. Main duties include developing interactive online learning and teaching packages by adapting and experimenting with innovative instructional design, multimedia, and relevant technologies, editing and/or supervising the development of instructional materials, e.g., video and web design/editing, working as a team to design online workshops and/or training materials for teaching and support staff, providing individual support/coaching to project members, facilitate workshop support and compile reports.

The appointee will also be expected to carry out other duties as assigned by the supervisor. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree, preferably a Master's Degree in Educational Technology, Information Technology in Education, Technology-enhanced Learning, Education, Psychology, Computer Sciences, or related disciplines, with several years of post-qualification working experience, preferably gained in tertiary institutions. They should have proficiency in common e-learning tools, excellent language skills in both English and Chinese, great attention to detail, and good interpersonal and communication skills. Applicants with knowledge and experience in the development of learning and teaching materials, and project management will be an advantage. Immediate availability is preferred. Candidates with less experience may be considered for the post of Project Assistant.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
