Project Title: Toward an effective gamification design in higher education: Validating a theoretical GAFCC-F model using design-based research

The appointee will work on a research project on using a gamification approach to enhance students' learning performance and course engagement. He/She will support the research team in planning, conducting, and coordinating the project activities. The appointee will conduct literature review, data collection, data entry, data management and analysis, report and manuscript writing, and liaison with collaborators, and performing any other duties as assigned. The appointment will be for a period of around 4 months.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Education, or a related discipline and be interested in Gamified Education. They should have good command of communication, presentation, and interpersonal skills in both written and spoken English; strong administrative and management skills; research knowledge and skills in using SPSS; enthusiasm, self-motivation, and the ability to work independently and under pressure. Experience with social network analysis and systematic review will be an asset.
