Project title: Provision of Consultancy Service on Dynamic Deployment of Emergency Ambulance Service in Hong Kong

The appointee will be responsible for supporting a research project for determining the optimal dynamic deployment of emergency service and developing a simulation tool with visualization of redeployment of emergency service. He/she will assist in writing program codes for determining the optimal dynamic deployment scheme, developing the simulation tool, and performing other duties as assigned by the project leader(s). The appointment will be for a period of around 8 months.

For the post of Senior Research Assistant, applicants should have a Master's degree preferably in Data Science, Operational Management, Computer Science, or a related discipline, plus at least oneyear full-time work experience. They should also be a good team player, attentive to details, wellorganized and self-motivated. Preference will be given to those with prior experience in heuristic optimization, GIS data analysis, and machine learning. Immediate availability is preferred.

Applicants with lower qualifications may be considered as Research Assistant I, for which applicants should have a Bachelor's degree in Data Science, Operational Management, Computer Science, or other related fields, preferably with relevant post-qualification full-time work experience.
