The appointee will provide support to a project related to mental health of pre-service teachers. He/she will be responsible to provide assistances in conducting qualitative and quantitative research, data collection analysis, report writing, organizing seminars and workshops, developing teaching and learning materials, and other administrative duties. The appointment will be for a period of 1 year, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

The Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree in psychology or related discipline. Preference will be given to applicants with a Master degree or relevant post-qualification working experiences. Applicants should have good data analysis skills (i.e. SPSS) and demonstrate computer literacy (i.e. use of MS Word, Excel, Chinese word processing, database creation and management). Applicants should also have a good command of English and Chinese and be able to work independently with good planning, organization and interpersonal skills.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
