The appointee will provide administrative and executive support to the Dean of Students and the Student Affairs Office including support to committees, quality assurance matters and projects related to student affairs. He/she is also required to provide support to the development of hall-life education programmes, assisting in survey design, distribution, data analysis and report writing; liaising with internal departments and external parties, and performing other duties as assigned.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree with substantial post-qualification working experience, preferably in administrative and student development work in the tertiary education sector. He/she should have high proficiency in English and Chinese language (Cantonese and Putonghua); strong writing and presentation skills; sound experience in committee work; interest in working with students; effective interpersonal and communication skills; knowledge of statistical software and a good level of computer literacy. Independence, multi-tasking and attention to details are essential.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
