The Centre for Psychosocial Health (CPH) is conducting timely research to respond to the societal and public health crises and to address pubic mental health with both local and global considerations. The post-doctoral fellow will play a critical role in supporting the Centre Director and Members, planning and conducting research, as well as leading/supporting academic publications. He/she will also supervise research assistant(s) in the implementation of projects and dissemination of research findings, and perform any other duties as assigned by supervisor(s). The appointment will be for 12 months.

Applicants should have a Ph.D. degree in psychology, public health, sociology, quantitative social sciences, or a relevant discipline, a demonstrated record of publishing academic research papers, an excellent command of written and verbal English and Chinese (Putonghua and Cantonese), good interpersonal, organizational, and problem-solving skills, and experiences and self-motivation to work independently or in a multidisciplinary team.
