The appointee will be responsible for some or all of the following: (a) providing human resources services to Faculties / Departments / Offices / Centres which include appointment and reappointment, benefit administration, training and development, performance appraisal, staff records and system maintenance; (b) providing administrative and clerical support to supervisors in formulating/reviewing human resources policies and procedures in the responsible subject areas; and (c) performing other duties such as compilation of management information reports and statistics, maintenance of filing system, and general office administration.

Applicants should have a recognized degree preferably with some relevant working experience in administrative work in sizable organizations. They should also have good interpersonal and communication skills; be proficient in both English and Chinese (including Putonghua) and literate in computer applications such as MS Word, Excel and PowerPoint.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

The appointee will be offered the functional title of Human Resources Officer which holds the substantive post of Human Resources Assistant in the University.
