The appointment will be 6 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Preferably with a Bachelor's degree in Computer Science, Statistics, Engineering, Data Science or a related field with years of research experience in artificial intelligence, machine learning, data science or a related field; good problem-solving, decision-making, communication, interpersonal, and organization skills; self-motivated, proactive, and able to multitask; excellent command of written and spoken English and Chinese; good knowledge of programming and related AI frameworks, etc; ability to work independently and as a team. They should be flexible and able to work under pressure.
