This is in response to the difficult labour market situation in the wake of the pandemic, with an aim of providing employment opportunities for those with different skill sets, qualifications and years of experience. Applications are invited for the captioned position.

The appointee will be responsible for a series of mini-research projects on teachers and teaching with an integrated research approach across psychology and education. The appointee will assist the project team in conducting literature reviews, data analyses, preparing research and teaching materials, drafting academic papers, report writing, project coordination and administration, and other duties as assigned. He or she should be familiar with quantitative and qualitative data analysis and can master computer software (SPSS, NVivo, word, excel, etc.) competently, and have knowledge and skills in the use of multimedia and website development. The appointment will be for around 12 months, immediate availability is preferred.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree in Psychology or a related discipline, with a strong interest in educational psychology and teaching. They should be highly proficient in both English and Chinese, Cantonese speaking is preferred. Experience in academic research and publication would be a definite advantage. Applicants should be self-motivated, highly organized, able to work independently and collaboratively, and committed to advancing knowledge through research.
