

## Teaching Assistant (Ref: 2300563) Department of Curriculum and Instruction

The Department of Curriculum and Instruction is seeking an inspirational and energetic candidate as a Teaching Assistant to support its growing scope of learning and teaching initiatives and endeavors. This is an exciting opportunity for those who wish to be part of a committed and enthusiastic team eager to develop their career in higher education.

Successful applicants will join teams of highly qualified educators in delivering a wide variety of learning and teaching activities. Under the guidance of mentors, his/her responsibilities mainly include (i) conducting various teaching activities such as tutorials, consultations, and in-class case discussions for pre-service/in-service teachers; (ii) assisting in the preparation of course materials (such as PPT, videos and lecture notes) and self-access learning materials on the e-platform; (iii) offering bilingual (Chinese and English) language support to undergraduate and postgraduate students, such as writing consultations and in-class simultaneous interpretation; (iv) providing administrative support for teaching activities, such as liaison with external and internal parties, management of e-platforms and database, organization of fieldwork/trips/academic exchange activities, on-site technical support, publication, publicity, and committee work and (v) performing other duties as assigned by mentors/the department head

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree, preferably a Master's degree, in Education or a relevant discipline, with sound knowledge of the Hong Kong education system and frontline practice. Applicants who possess a relevant professional teaching certificate, such as a PGDE or Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) recognized by the HK EDB or an equivalent qualification, are highly preferred. They should have a good command of both written English and Chinese, and proficiency in spoken English and Putonghua is preferred. Additionally, they should be self-motivated, well-organized, have good interpersonal and communication skills, be able to work independently and as part of a team, and have the ability to work under pressure. Applicants with frontline teaching experience are highly desirable.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits, and where applicable.
