The appointee will undertake a wide range of executive duties, including developing and implementing marketing strategies that publicize the department's teaching, research, and programmes locally and internationally; planning and executing events, such as seminars and conferences, to promote the department's activities; developing and managing digital marketing campaigns, including social media and paid advertising; writing compelling marketing copy and video scripts, and developing marketing collateral, such as brochures, flyers, and other promotional materials; collaborating with external partners, such as media outlets and other organizations to develop and execute marketing campaigns; monitoring and analyzing the effectiveness of marketing efforts, and providing regular report; overseeing a wide range of engagement activities such as school outreach, website construction, and social media content and initiatives; provide guidance and supervision to junior staff; and perform other duties as assigned by the supervisors.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree and with at least 7 years of post-qualification working experience in relevant positions. They should possess strong communication and organization skills, excellent leadership and problem-solving skills, self-motivated, proactive, and able to multi-task. They should have excellent command of written and spoken English and Chinese (Cantonese and Putonghua) and good knowledge of computer applications, video production, website construction, and experience in working at local tertiary education institutions is preferred. They should be flexible and able to work under pressure.
