The Academy of Hong Kong Studies (AHKS), established in July 2015, is the first academy dedicated to fostering Hong Kong Studies within local tertiary institutions. It is an interdisciplinary academy at The Education University of Hong Kong.

The appointee will support Professor Stephen Chiu in an evaluation project on entrepreneurial education innovations in secondary schools. He/she will conduct intensive interviews, surveys, and observations on site in the schools, as well as transcription and analysis of the data collected afterwards.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree or above and have solid backgrounds in research methods and especially qualitative skills. Fluent Cantonese and knowledge of the local education system are necessary for the implementation of the fieldwork."
