The appointment will be 12 months.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Artificial Intelligence, Data Science or a related discipline with strong interpersonal and communication skills, good command of both written and spoken English, self-motivation, and the ability to work independently, preferably with some experience in 3D design and mobile app development.
