Project Title: Education on green urban development and social entrepreneurship as a tool for developing life and positive values among ethnic minorities in Hong Kong with an impact on EdUHK students

The project plans to explore ethnic minorities' understanding of sustainable urban development and expose ethnic minorities to education about environmental issues and positive values through nonformal learning to help them better understand environmental issues and to develop their competencies for identifying opportunities related to solutions of these issues. The overall aim is to contribute towards the sustainable development of Hong Kong.

The appointee will be responsible for providing research and administrative support to the project. His/her duties include but are not limited to providing research support, conducting literature reviews, setting up and conducting knowledge transfer activities in the form of workshops, working with research collaborators, developing research instruments, administrating data collection, data entry and analysis, drafting reports, manuscripts, manuals for NGOs and to perform any other related duties as assigned by the project leader. The appointee is expected to engage with different stakeholders including NGOs, ethnic minority groups, and on-campus students. The appointment will be for a period of around 12 months up to the project end date.

Applicants should have a master's degree in Education, Educational Development or other related disciplines, plus one-year post master's degree full-time working or research experience, preferably in the areas of education for sustainable development, green transitions, and engagement with disadvantaged groups in green urban development, or a doctoral degree. Proficiency in both written and spoken English is required. The applicants should also possess good organizational, interpersonal, communication, and ICT skills, be attentive to details, be highly motivated, and be able to multitask. Availability from mid-October is required.
