

## Post-doctoral Fellow (Ref: 2301102) Artificial Intelligence and Digital Competency Education Centre

The appointee will be responsible for providing research support for a large-scale artificial intelligence (AI) literacy project. Duties include conducting literature review on AI literacy, developing and validating research instruments; conducting quantitative and qualitative data analysis; writing academic papers and reports on AI literacy; reviewing the learning and teaching resources on AI literacy developed by the project team; as well as performing other duties assigned by the project principal investigator. The appointment will be for a period of 24 months.

Applicants should have a Doctoral Degree in Psychology, Education, Artificial Intelligence and/or related disciplines, with strong statistical analysis ability. Applicants should have an excellent command of written English and Chinese, be proficient in spoken Cantonese, high capability of conducting statistical analysis, and writing academic papers and reports independently. A sound background in statistics and experience in using statistical packages such as SPSS and R, is advantageous. They should be self-motivated and able to work as a team member. Applicants with academic background and research experience in related fields would be preferable.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
