Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent, preferably with a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology, Medical, Computer Science or a related discipline. He/she should have strong interpersonal and communication skills, good command of both written and spoken English and Chinese, be responsible, organized and attentive to details, enthusiasm, self-motivation, ability to work independently, and committed to advance knowledge through research. Experience in supporting research and training programmes, using statistic software (e.g., R studio) in data analysis, with/are confident to learn EEG/ERP technique will be an advantage.
