If you have a commitment to equity, diversity and inclusion (EDI), you are invited to consider a Research Assistant position in the Department of Education Policy and Leadership. You will provide support to an interdisciplinary research project that will focus on EDI, technology and higher education leadership.

The appointees will assist in research activities including but not limited to conducting literature review; organizing and conducting surveys, interviews; carrying out data management and analysis; producing draft reports, research articles and conference papers; creating website and managing webcontents; organizing workshops and seminars; and performing any other duties as required. They will need to work with multiple researchers concurrently. The appointment will be for a period of 30 months.

Applicants should have a Bachelor Degree in a related subject discipline, preferably with relevant working experience, or a Master Degree. Experience of research project management, including an outcome-oriented approach, along with interpersonal skills to liaise with various stakeholders and preferably working experience with higher education leaders will be an advantage. They should be proficient in Microsoft office applications, data analysis software such as SPSS, NVivo etc., and social media. They should be able to work independently and collaboratively. Good command in spoken and written English language skills is a must.
