Specific duties include conducting literature review, database management, data analysis, and drafting research reports. He/she is also expected to perform administrative support to the Principal Investigator. The initial appointment will be for a period of six months with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology, Neuroscience, Computer Science, or related disciplines. They should have high proficiency in both English and Chinese. They should be enthusiastic, self-motivated, able to work independently and have strong academic writing competency. Experience with big data research, fMRI, machine learning, and being able to use relevant software (e.g., R, Python) to perform data analysis will be an advantage.
