- 1. Using an integrated framework of cognitive control and a transdiagnostic dimensional approach to understand psychopathology: A pilot study
- 2. Developing a home-based executive function training program for autistic individuals

The appointee will work on research projects on executive control, mental health, and psychopathology. He/she will support the research team in planning, conducting, and coordinating the project activities. The appointee will conduct literature review, data collection, data entry, data management and analysis, report and manuscript writing, and liaison with collaborators and schools/organizations. The initial appointment will be for a period of 4 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

The applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in psychology, cognitive neuroscience, or a related discipline; interest in understanding mental health and psychopathology; good communication, presentation, and interpersonal skills in both written and spoken English and Chinese (Cantonese); strong administrative and management skills; research knowledge and skills in using SPSS; enthusiasm, self-motivation, and the ability to work independently and under pressure.
