Project Title: Language and Communication Matters: Understanding the Developmental Trajectory of Linguistic, Cognitive, and Social-emotional Skills in Chinese Children with Speech and Language Difficulties

[Appointment Period: 12-24 months]

The appointee will design and carry out research studies and evaluate the effectiveness of the project, overseeing such research procedures as study design, protocol development, school recruitment, data collection, data management, and data analysis. He/she will work closely with top researchers and professionals within and across universities and NGOs. Also, the appointee will present findings in academic and non-technical ways, in English and Chinese, so that both professionals and laymen, local and international, can understand the importance of the project. The appointee should have leadership qualities, as he/she will supervise a research assistant and a group of student helpers to conduct both quantitative and qualitative research.

Depending on the job performance of the appointee, he/she may be given chances to write academic papers based on existing data and to do presentations at international conferences with financial support from the Centre. The appointment period can be up to 2 years, depending on the appointee's qualifications and experience.

Applicants should have a Doctoral Degree in Psychology, Education, Social Sciences, or related disciplines, plus several years of experience in conducting research. He/she should be able to use statistical software to conduct both basic and advanced analyses, such as regression, ANOVAs, growth analysis, path analysis, and SEM. He/she should also have excellent writing skills in both Chinese and English, be research-oriented and self-motivated, and be able to accomplish tasks both independently and collaboratively. Experience in publishing in academic journals and evaluating programme effectiveness are advantages. Applicants with a Master's Degree in related areas and substantial research experience may be considered for the position of Senior Research Assistant. Applicants for Senior Research Assistant should have a Master's Degree, plus one-year post Master's degree full-time working experience.
