

## Lecturer II (Ref: 2400214) Centre for Language in Education

The Centre for Language in Education provides Chinese enhancement programmes and services for students in the EdUHK. The appointee will be responsible for teaching courses in Cantonese as the medium of instruction; providing various kinds of language services, e.g. co-curricular and extracurricular activities and one-to-one teacher-student consultative sessions; assisting in the administration of courses and assessments; contributing to the development of teaching and learning materials; and building network with the Greater Bay Area (GBA) region. He/she will also be expected to contribute to the Centre's projects and initiatives.

Applicants should have a Master's degree in Chinese language/Chinese language education, with relevant post-qualification teaching experience. They should preferably possess a relevant professional teaching certificate, e.g. PGDE or qualification of Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) recognized by the Education Bureau of Hong Kong or other qualification of equivalence, and provide proven evidence of quality teaching and/or successful record of relevant professional experience at secondary or tertiary level. Relevant post-qualification teaching experience is preferable. They should also demonstrate a good command of Cantonese, Putonghua, and English. Experiences in digital language teaching, e-learning of languages, and vocational language teaching are highly preferable.
