Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree in Marketing, Translation, Communication, Journalism, or a related discipline, with several years of post-qualification full-time work experience and some managerial experiences, preferably in tertiary institutions. Applicants should also be highly proficiency in English and Chinese (including Putonghua) and computer applications such as Microsoft Office and Canva; have strong communication, writing, editing and project management skills; be proactive, innovative, and able to work under pressure. Prior experience in event management, managing social media, using graphic design software or promoting academic programmes will be an advantage. Immediate availability is preferred.
