The appointee will be responsible for supporting the research project. He/ She will produce 3D models (preferably with Blender), prepare the assessment guidelines for the integrative educational applications of motion capture (mocap) and generative artificial intelligence (AI) technologies, assist in the coordination and administrative work of the project, support data collection and data analysis, write reports, and perform any other duties assigned by the Project Leader or his delegate(s). The appointment will be around twenty months.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree, preferably with work experience in multimedia development, 3D modelling and texturing, rigging for 3D models, or 3D movie production with high proficiency in both English and Chinese. He/ She should also be a good team player, attentive to details, well-organised and self-motivated. The Project Leader will provide the initial training on mocap technologies. Immediate availability is preferred.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
