The Department of Literature and Cultural Studies now seeks applications for the post of Lecturer I/II in the area of Classical and/or Modern Chinese literature, history, and/or cultural studies. In addition to course teaching, the appointee will participate in activities related to project supervision, field experience supervision, internship supervision, guidance to students in the capacity of personal tutors, and so on. The appointee is expected to contribute to curriculum and programme development, programme and course management and partake in departmental activities and represent the Department in meetings and various boards and committees, and provide good service contributions to the University and the community. The appointee will be expected to commence employment around August 2024.

Applicants should have at least a Master's degree, preferably a doctoral degree in a relevant subject discipline along with a minimum of 4 years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience. Applicants with less relevant post-qualification teaching experience in the subject applied for will be considered for the post of Lecturer II. Applicants should preferably possess a relevant professional teaching certificate, such as a Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE) or a qualification of Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) recognized by the Education Bureau of Hong Kong, or an equivalent qualification, or evidence of quality teaching experience in higher education institutions. Familiarity with the field of digital humanities, education, and/or comparative cultures of care will be considered advantageous.
